Bright Bridge Ministries is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, faith-centered ministry dedicated to providing food, recovery services, housing and spiritual guidance to those in need. Since 2007, Bright Bridge has worked with Escambia County's most vulnerable and under-resourced residents: homeless individuals and families, children living in poverty, U.S. veterans, mentally ill, former inmates, substance abusers and others in need.

Purpose

Bright Bridge is hiring a full-time (40 hours per week) caseworker to work with individuals living in poverty and with those who are homeless.

Salary

\$50,000 for one year

Responsibilities

- Filing and maintaining case history reports through the Homeless Management Data System
- Interviewing clients to assess their situational needs
- Determining which services and assistance are necessary
- Serving as a liaison between the client and social, financial, health and legal services
- Developing a plan of action to improve the client's well-being
- Planning regular follow-ups to assess progress and additional needs
- Reviewing and modifying plans as circumstances change for the individual

Qualifications

College degree, preferably in social work, psychology, or sociology and/or experience working with the homeless population
