### **OVERVIEW**

The Campaign Advisory Cabinet helps guide the strategy and attainment of United Way of Escambia County (UWEC)'s annual campaign goal, making it possible for UWEC to fulfill its mission of improving lives. The Cabinet also raises awareness about UWEC's Community Impact work in the areas of health, education, and financial stability.

The Campaign Advisory Cabinet is a group of volunteers who represent many professional fields in Escambia County. Members are chosen for their expertise within their sector and involvement in the community. Cabinet members will have an opportunity to engage various community members in UWEC's campaign and gain unique networking opportunities as a result.

The term begins in January and runs through December. Members should attend a minimum of 50% of the monthly meetings. Between meetings, Cabinet members may be asked to spend another 1-2 hours a month performing certain tasks including setting up and/or attending meetings with community contacts, donor appreciation activities, and advocating for UWEC's work.

UWEC's Development Team and the UWEC Board of Directors Campaign Committee will support the Cabinet and provide them with the resources they need to be successful. UWEC staff will organize meetings, provide training, keep the Cabinet informed of team progress toward goals, and prepare communications & materials necessary for the successful attainment of campaign goals.

The Campaign Advisory Cabinet will have a unique behind-the-scenes look at how UWEC obtains the resources needed to change our community. Together, we will focus on enhancing connections, building new relationships, and thriving in our community.

### **RESPONSIBILITES**

- Help UWEC build long-standing relationships with key organizations and individuals in Escambia County.
- Assist UWEC in developing and implementing strategies to grow financial resources including individual giving, workplace campaign contributions, corporate gifts, and sponsorships.
- Provide thoughtful leadership in creating an annual campaign plan, campaign materials, and improving our message to donors.
- Attend CEO/workplace coordinator visits and other campaign activities; speak at campaign events (as schedule permits).
- Serve as an advocate. Help inspire passion for UWEC's work and create champions for our cause by
  engaging your sphere of influence. Leverage relationships to help UWEC staff and Board "get in the door" with
  leaders of our community.
- Assist UWEC staff with the identification of prospective new employee workplace campaigns, sponsors, and donors. Support UWEC staff with brainstorming new approaches to troubled accounts.
- Attend monthly Campaign Advisory Cabinet meetings.
- Participate in UWEC annual events including the Annual Meeting and Campaign Kickoff Luncheon.
- Give thoughtful consideration to making a monetary donation to UWEC's Community Investment Fund at a level that is significant to you.
